1. Venue

The 3rd RG65 International Trophy will be held at Clube Naval Charitas, address Av. Carlos Ermelindo Marins 70, Jurujuba, Niterói, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

2. Programme

3. Rules

The event will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including this Notice of Race (NoR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI).

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

The English language version of these documents shall prevail.

4. Organising Authority

The 3rd RG65 International Trophy is organised by the Associação Brasileira de Vela Rádio Controlada (ABVRC) and Associação Brasileira da Classe RG65 and supervised by the Confederação Brasileira de Vela (CBVela) and the RG65 International Class Association (RG65 ICA).

5. Eligibility

The competition is open to RG65 class boats complying with the RG65 Class Rules. The Brazilian competitors must have paid the national fee for the RG65 class.

6. Registration

A valid RG65 Class Certificate for each boat must be presented at registration. Boats shall be presented for registration and equipment inspection on 1st September 2014. No boat shall be eligible to race until it has been registered and has passed equipment inspection.

7. Scoring and Racing System

The Championship will be raced and scored under the Heat Management System (HMS).

8. Sailing instructions

The sailing instructions will be provided by the end of the period of registration.

9. Entries

Entry forms and fees must be received by the organisers on or before June 30, 2014. The entry fee of R\$ 600 (around US\$ 260) per competitor, net of bank charges, is to be paid with the submission of the entry. These fees may be paid by Paypal transfer on the championship web page. For Brazilian competitors, the fee may be paid by bank deposit, according to the following values and dates:

10. Equipment Inspection

It is intended that all boats will pass equipment inspection on 1st September 2014. Nonetheless, the Race Committee may at any time request the Equipment Inspector to confirm that a boat complies with the RG65 Class Rules. Random spot checks may be made throughout the event.

11. Frequencies

Each competitor must have a minimum of 3 frequencies available. An exception to the minimum number of frequencies is granted in the case of systems operating on 2.4 GHz.

12. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first 5 (five) positions in the final results.

13. Liability

All those entering or taking part in this Championship do so at their own risk and responsibility. The RG65 International Class Association, the Naval Charitas Club, the Associação Brasileira de Vela Rádio Controlada, the Associação Brasileira da Classe RG65 and any other parties involved in the organisation of this event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the Championship covered by this Notice of Race.

At all times the responsibility for the safety of their boat and themselves including the decision to participate or continue shall rest with the competitor. By entering the event it is deemed that you accept these conditions. Competitors are advised to ensure that they have adequate personal insurance that provides cover for public liability and their possible injury in Brazil.
