



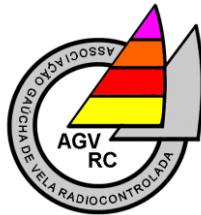

RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- a) The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E,
- b) The IOM international Class and Championship regulations of ISAF-IRSA,
- c) This Notice of Race (NOR),
- d) HMS 2014 v2,
- e) The Sailing Instructions (SI), the Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.
- f) The Equipment Rules of Sailing
- g) No National prescriptions will apply.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Competition is open to all IOM class boats. Seventy-six competitors will be accepted as per para. 8 of the class Championship Rules. The competition is open to International One Metre class boats in good standing with IOMICA and IRSA. The ISAF Regulations regarding eligibility apply with the additional requirements of the IOMICA Class Championship Regulations.

COMPETITOR:

All entrants must be current members of ABVRC or their National Authority

Boat:

Must have a valid IOM measurement certificate.

SCORING SYSTEM:

The Championship will be raced and scored under the Heat Management System (HMS). 2014 v2.

Promotion/Relegation Six-(6). The number of boats promoted and relegated may be adjusted by notice in the SI's or at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer at the skippers meeting.

Entries shall be limited to 76 boats.

Five completed races shall constitute the championship.

DISCARDS:

After 4 races – 1 discard

After 8 races – 2 discards

After 16 races – 3 discards

After 24 races – 4 discards

....and so on. One discard for every 8 completed races.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be available before hand on the event website.

CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The National Jury and the IOMICA event delegate shall approve changes in the Sailing Instructions.

Any change of the Sailing Instructions shall be posted on the Official Notice Board and shall take effect from the first heat of a new race. However, changes to the Control Area, Launching Area and Practice Area will take effect from the next heat. When a notice is posted the race committee will make two sound signals followed by a hail announcing that a change has been posted.

FREQUENCIES:

Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. The permitted frequency bands are 26, 27, 50, 75 MHz and 2.4 GHz. Each competitor must have a minimum of 3 frequencies available except on 2.4 GHz.

ENTRY & FEES:

Entries shall be made using the official **EVENT'S ENTRY FORM**, which must be endorsed by the competitor. Boat certificates and entry form must be forwarded to: armando@polimate.com.br.

The deadline for the 2015 IOM BRA NCR is August 31st.
